Colombian-born and worldwide-trained Opera and Orchestra Conductor. Music Director of The Americas Chamber Orchestra at Bloomington Indiana, USA; Music Director of the Opera Summer Camp (CASC) at Los Angeles California-USA; and Doctoral Student of Opera and Orchestra Conducting at the Prestigious Jacobs School of Music from Indiana University (Indiana, USA) as Scholarship holder of Graduate Tuition Award and Artistic Excellence Award.

Referenced by the International Press as "Musical Genius" and "synonymous of energy, knowledge and confidence of high artistic quality". Due to his outstanding international career, Maestro Barbosa-Vásquez was named by ProColombia as Ambassador of Colombia Country Brand. In addition is Professional Member as Opera and Orchestra Conductor of the League of American Orchestras.

Guest conductor for the 70 anniversary of UNICEF concert, the Colombian Maestro has been winning international recognition since conducting in El Salvador (2014), his 1st. International Opera Conductors Competition in Belgium (Opera Royal de Wallonie) (2017) and the III Nino Rota International Conducting Competition at Italy (2018), in last both cases representing Latinamerica. In addition, he was special guest lecturer at the 11th European Orchestra Festival of (EOFed) and WFAO General Assembly (2018 - Norway) and special guest lecturer at the WFAO General Assembly (2019 - Singapore) also representing LatinAmerica.

Diego has been Guest Conductor of the Wabash Valley Youth Symphony (IN, USA), OCSA Symphony Orchestra (CA, USA), Youth Symphony Orchestra of El Salvador (El Salvador), Caldas Symphony Orchestra (Caldas, Colombia) and Choir and Founding Orchestra of Esperanza Azteca Program (Puebla, México). Recognized by Colfuturo - Colombia as "Talented Pride of Colombia" Maestro Diego was Artistic & Music Director of the World Music Symphony Orchestra in California-USA, Music and Artistic Director of Huila Philharmonic, Chief Conductor of E&P® Symphony Orchestra, Symphony Orchestra of Huila Conservatory and Rock Symphony Orchestra. Diego was chief Conductor of E&P Choirs of Cajicá, Colina and Aparecida; Choral Conductor at "Tocar y Luchar Cafam-Colombia" and Head of the Virrey Solís-E&P Conservatory. As performer Maestro Barbosa-Vásquez was Principal Viola at Caldas Symphony Orchestra, Juan N. Corpas Symphony Orchestra, Colombia Joven Symphony Orchestra, Camerata Acordanza, Orchestra of the "Art and Opera for All Foundation", Unimúsica Symphony Orchestra, Bogotá Symphony Orchestra FOSBO, and Scholarship holder and Founder of the Colombian Young Philharmonic (FJC).

Diego holds a M.M. (Master in Music Degree - Graduated with honors) in Opera and Orchestra Conducting at Azusa Pacific University (CA, USA) as recipient of full assistantship and John Simons scholarship. There he worked as Assistant Conductor of APU Symphony Orchestra, APU Opera Theater and Guest Conductor of the Studio Orchestra and APU Musical Theater Company. In addition, he holds a Maestro in Music degree from Juan N. Corpas University Music School (Bogotá D.C., Colombia) graduated with honors with Major in Conducting and Minors in Viola and Chamber Music. Furthermore, he is graduated from Global Leaders Program of OA (Orchestra of the Americas) as Conductor and Violist.

His principal conducting professors are Arthur Fagen (From Indiana University - USA), Christopher Russell (From Azusa Pacific University - USA) and Jorge Alejandro Salazar (From Corpas University - Colombia).
